Spring has arrived! Time to get out and trim up those bushes, shrubs, and trees that are hanging over sidewalks, walking paths, and roads or driveways. See page 6, Specific Design Guidelines Section A - Maintenance.

It is also time to schedule the power washing of our homes, per ACC Guidelines Section VI Specific Design Guidelines - A Maintenance. Removing mold/mildew to maintaining a clean exterior appearance. This is done by yearly power washing between March 31st - May 31st. Please be sure this is done correctly either by a professional or yourself. A \$100 fine can and will occur if this is not done by May 31, 2020. The ACC Board will inspect each home the first week of June. Should you complete power washing early, please advise us so that we can inspect your home and check it off the list.

We would like to thank those who have submitted the ACC Design Submittal Form for any home improvement projects done this past year. Timely submittals have enabled the ACC and Bundy Management to focus on other issues or concerns.

During these upcoming months many of us like to make changes or repairs to our homes.
