**COVID-19** As most are aware, COVID-19 cases have risen dramatically again in our locale, with Beaufort County being designated as a "hot spot" area for the illness. The new Delta variant being deemed as more harmful, aggressive and spreading quicker than the previous variant, even in the younger population, which has added to the growing pandemic. Slowing vaccine rates, and individuals paying less attention to masking and social distancing have been identified as other key factors in the viruses ability to mutate and become more prevalent once again.
